

2021 TURLEY "FREDERICKS VINEYARD" ZINFANDEL, SONOMA VALLEY

HISTORY

Hailing from 1937, these certified organic vines are some of the most unique we've ever seen. Just a mile and a half from the Napa border on the Sonoma side of the Mayacamas, located in what is the new Moon Mountain AVA, the vines are planted along steep, contoured terraces. Finding old vineyards is rare enough, but historic hillside head-trained vines located 1000 feet up? Downright extraordinary.

TASTING NOTES

Certified organic, planted 1937 at about 1000 ft up Moon Mountain. Fragrant nose of plum, lavender, black cherry, graphite, anise, herbs, and roasted coffee. A liberal dose of mountain tannins adds additional gravitas. The overall effect is wondrous, and the powerful finish left us awestruck. Don't miss this wine in 2021. Lay it down or decant and serve at 55°-60°F.
